**Re. Year 13 Mentor period changes**

I am writing to inform you that our year 13 mentor period (Monday's period 1) will be changing in structure and format. As from **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019**, we will be providing students with a series of teacher led lessons that will revisit content (in a lecture style format) or practicing exam style questions in timed conditions. These sessions will run until **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019** (excluding Easter holidays). The reasoning behind this change is to move towards a more academic focus leading up to the final exams.

Please find attached a list of subjects and teachers that will be running these sessions and a list of topic areas that will be covered each week.

Your son/daughter will need to choose which session to attend and sign in with their teachers. The plan attached will give students flexibility to decide what session to go to, in particular if they have one running for 2 or 3 of their subjects.

Unfortunately, due to timetabling issues, not all subjects will be able to provide this service. However, students will be expected to sign in with Ms. Britton in room 1.08, if they do not have a session to go to. This room will be for silent private study and will include resources from subjects that are not offering sessions. If students do not go to a session or sign in with Ms. Britton, it will go down as an unauthorised absence.
