Our determination to provide the highest quality of education for all children remains relentless and is supported in particular by our Local Governing Body and our current Executive Head and Vice CEO Ash Rahman, who will continue to work closely with us in the future.



This work has been highly commended as exemplar practice and we were accredited as one of only 14 lead schools in the country last Autumn term by NACE (National Association for Able Children in Education), in recognition of our ambitious curriculum planning and teaching and learning across the school.

Our Trust has always maintained that the educational partnership that exists between our schools provides an exciting opportunity to develop excellence for all children, in all communities. With this in mind, I am pleased to inform you that I have secured a position to lead on Curriculum Development across all secondary schools within the Trust, from September 2020, whilst taking on the Executive Headship of Melton Vale Sixth Form and Toot Hill School, where I will be based. I feel incredibly lucky to be able to do this whilst maintaining close strategic ties with this very special school and community.
