Good afternoon

Following my earlier letter I wanted to reassure you that our school and Nova Education Trust have spent this week seeking guidance and clarity from the DfE, in response to the Government's statement last weekend, that secondary schools might open for some 'face to face contact' with Year 10 and 12 students, before the summer holidays. We remain fully committed to planning responsibly for this to happen, when safe for staff and students, but still await significant detail before these plans will be thorough enough to enact safely.
